Pastor's Message

Dear St. Mark's Lutheran Church,

As we enter the month of November, we are reminded that this time of year often invites us to reflect on gratitude, humility, and our connection to one another under God's grace. In this spirit, I'd like to bring our attention to the story of the Tower of Babel from Genesis 11—a story that holds a BIG and profound lesson in humility and unity.

In the story, the people of Babel, confident in their own strength and skills, set out to build a tower that would reach the heavens. They dreamed of making a name for themselves, forgetting the importance of humility and reliance on God. As their tower grew, so did their pride, until God intervened by confusing their language, scattering them across the earth. What began as a symbol of human achievement became a reminder of the importance of humility and the need for connection and understanding between people.

The story of Babel teaches us that when we focus too much on our own ambitions, we risk losing sight of the unity and love God desires for us. It reminds us that, rather than seeking glory for ourselves, we are called to be part of something BIGGER—God's kingdom. In our church community, we find strength in our shared faith, not in our individual pursuits. Our mission is fulfilled not by elevating ourselves but by lifting each other up, serving humbly, and coming together in the name of Christ.

As we gather for worship and fellowship this month, let us keep the lesson of Babel in our hearts. May we celebrate our unity in Christ, even as we embrace the diversity of our gifts, backgrounds, and experiences. Together, we can build a faith community that reaches far beyond any tower, rooted firmly in God's love and grace.

May November be a month of renewed faith and humble service for each of us, as we prepare our hearts for the Advent season and the hope of Christ's coming.
